### Strong Light of Day

Fifth-generation Texas Ranger Caitlin Strong is one of the most interesting protagonists in today's fiction. She comes from a long line of Rangers and as a strong, independent woman she can handle herself in any given situation. In **Strong Light of Day**, she uncovers a terrifying plot that dates back to the cold war.

Author Jon Land is a terrific writer who deftly weaves historical events into his intricate stories. **Strong Light of Day**, the seventh book in his Caitlin Strong series, is his best yet. I couldn't put it down until the very end.

In **Strong Light of Day**, Caitlin matches wits with a billionaire oilman who has managed to genetically engineer pesticide that could very well wipe out the entire country, and probably the world. 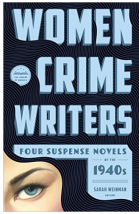
Discover this wonderful author and marvel at his ability to research and tell spellbinding stories

**Four Suspense Novels of the 1940s**

Sarah Weinman has given us the opportunity to read several mid-century thrillers written by the women who pioneered the genre. The first volume focuses on the 1940s and contains books by Vera Caspary, Helen Eustis, Dorothy Hughes and Elisabeth Sanxay Holding.

This reader started with a totally unfamiliar book and author, **THE BLANK WALL** by Elisabeth Sanxay Holding. And what a find.

Lucia Holley runs her upper middle-class household while her husband Tom is serving overseas during WWII. According to her letters to Tom, she seems consumed with the everyday details of managing her two children, her elderly father, and her housekeeper. But her sheltered existence is turned upside down when the dead body of her daughter's unsuitable boyfriend is found in the boathouse.

Mistaken assumptions, blackmail threats, inappropriate flirtations and the black market economy all contribute to the cold-heartedness that drives Lucia's actions. A seemingly simple suburban existence evolves into a truly noir story.

Fans who are looking for the next Gillian Flynn or Tana French should look back to these mid-century authors for wonderfully dark stories of domestic suspense. There is no time warp, since human motivations and relationships have not changed. A second volume is also available, focusing on the Women Crime Writers of the 1950s.

Although each volume costs 35.00, there are four books per volume. Works out to the price of a paperback per book. Well written, timeless, engaging, these books are one of this year's best discoveries.

The engagement between Emily's childhood friend Jeremy, Duke of Bainbridge, and an American heiress, appears to be a love match, even though engineered by the heiress's mother. The supposed suicide of the Duke's best friend, Chauncey Neville shatters the atmosphere of gaiety.

Emily and Colin, along with their friends, begin to see signs of something not quite right. Emily, who discovers she has an instinctive dislike of Jeremy's fiancée, begins to confide in some of the other women in the party.

Planned excursions continue after the death of Neville, but Emily and her friends uncover unsettling details that throw their assumptions into the proverbial cocked hat. The reality of what is actually happening opens Emily's eyes, but not before her life is endangered, and her reputation



smeared.

Tasha Alexander's historical mystery series is enlivened by this latest adventure.

Michael Hendricks is a hit man who kills other hit men. Classified as dead while on a covert mission for the military in Afghanistan, Hendricks left his old life behind, including his much loved fiancée. He earns 10 times the price on a potential victim's head.

After several hits, the inevitable happens. Hendricks becomes the hunted by not one, but two, pursuers. The association of the heads of different mobs wants him dead and sends a psychopathic assassin to kill him. He is also wanted by the FBI, seeking to capture him. The chase that ensues is breathtaking and compulsively readable.

Mr. Holm has created an anti-hero with just enough backstory to make him mostly likable. The action is fast paced and the story is driven by strong characters and well-written dialog. The reader is engaged from page one. It was impossible to put this thriller down.

### **The British Lion**

**The British Lion** by Tony Schumacher is an outstanding look at what might have happened had the Nazis won WWII.

The story begins in **The Darkest Hour**, now available in paperback, and continues in **The British Lion**. You don't have to read **Darkest Hour** first, but it is better if you do so you know the history of the characters and events.

The war has ended and the Germans have taken over Great Britain. London detective John Henry Rossett, now under the command of the Nazis, is in the hospital recovering from gunshot wounds until his boss, Ernst Kohler enlists his help. Kohler's wife and daughter have been kidnapped by American spies. At the same time, Germany is working to be number one in developing the atomic bomb.

Caught between the Nazi SS, the British resistance, and the Americans, Rossett secretly makes his way out of London to find Ruth Hartz, a Jewish scientist working in Cambridge. Hartz, spared from death by the Nazis because of her intellect and expertise, is being forced to work on developing the atomic bomb for Germany.

I love the way Schumacher expertly brings the reader into a fully believable story through the development of characters who seem a bit too real - maybe your next-door neighbor. **The British Lion** and **The Darkest Hour** will provide readers with many sleepless nights as this story unfolds.
